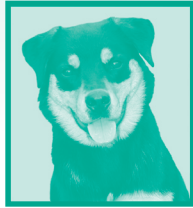
REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Pre-registration- \$25.00 for each participant. Fee includes T-shirt, course maps, support, snacks, and drinks.

\$30.00 registration after October, 29, 2010. Fee includes course map, support, and snacks and drinks. T-shirt cannot be guaranteed.

Registration begins at 8:30 a.m. Event starts at 10:00 a.m.

DIRECTIONS:

From Winchester (About 10 miles): Take Route 50 East (Exit 313 from I-81), the Arboretum is approximately 10 miles on the right, about 1.5 miles past the intersection of Route 50 and Route 340.

From Leesburg (About 45 miles): Take Route 7 West to Route 340 South at Berryville. Follow Route 340 and turn left onto Route 50 East at a traffic light. The Arboretum is approximately 1.5 miles on the right.

From Washington (About 70 miles): Take I-66 West to Rt. 17 North (Exit 23, sign says Delaplane/Paris). Follow Route 17 North to its junction with Route 50 West at a traffic light. Turn left onto Route 50/17, the Arboretum is approximately 7 miles on the left, about 3 miles past the Shenandoah River.
